WHAT TO PACK IN YOUR SHOEBOX

For children around the world, a shoebox is often their very first gift. Given together with the Good News of Jesus Christ, it communicates God's love to a boy or girl in need. So, it is important to make sure your gift is ...

- **FUN**—includes a “wow” item and other quality toys
- **FULL**—packed to the brim with additional school supplies and personal care items
- **PERSONALIZED**—prayed over and contains a note and photo, which are often the child's favorite items!

DO NOT PACK: Soap; candy; toothpaste; gum; used or damaged items; scary or war-related items such as toy guns, knives, or military figures; chocolate or food; seeds; fruit rolls or other fruit snacks; drink mixes (powdered or liquid); liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers; aerosol cans.
