Why Genesis Was Written

Written by Moses after the Exodus, Genesis was given to provide God's unique perspective to a nation immersed in Egyptian culture for 400 years.

The Four Foundations of Life from Genesis

"The most important thing in life is a relationship with God."



Based on Genesis 1-4.

Foundation 1: What is God?

“In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.” – Genesis 1:1

- **One God:** Not a pantheon. He is singular and eternal, existing outside of time and space.
- **Supremely Powerful:** He created the entire world by speaking it into being. Everything He made was good.
- **Good & Caring:** He placed Adam and Eve in a bountiful garden and met with them there.

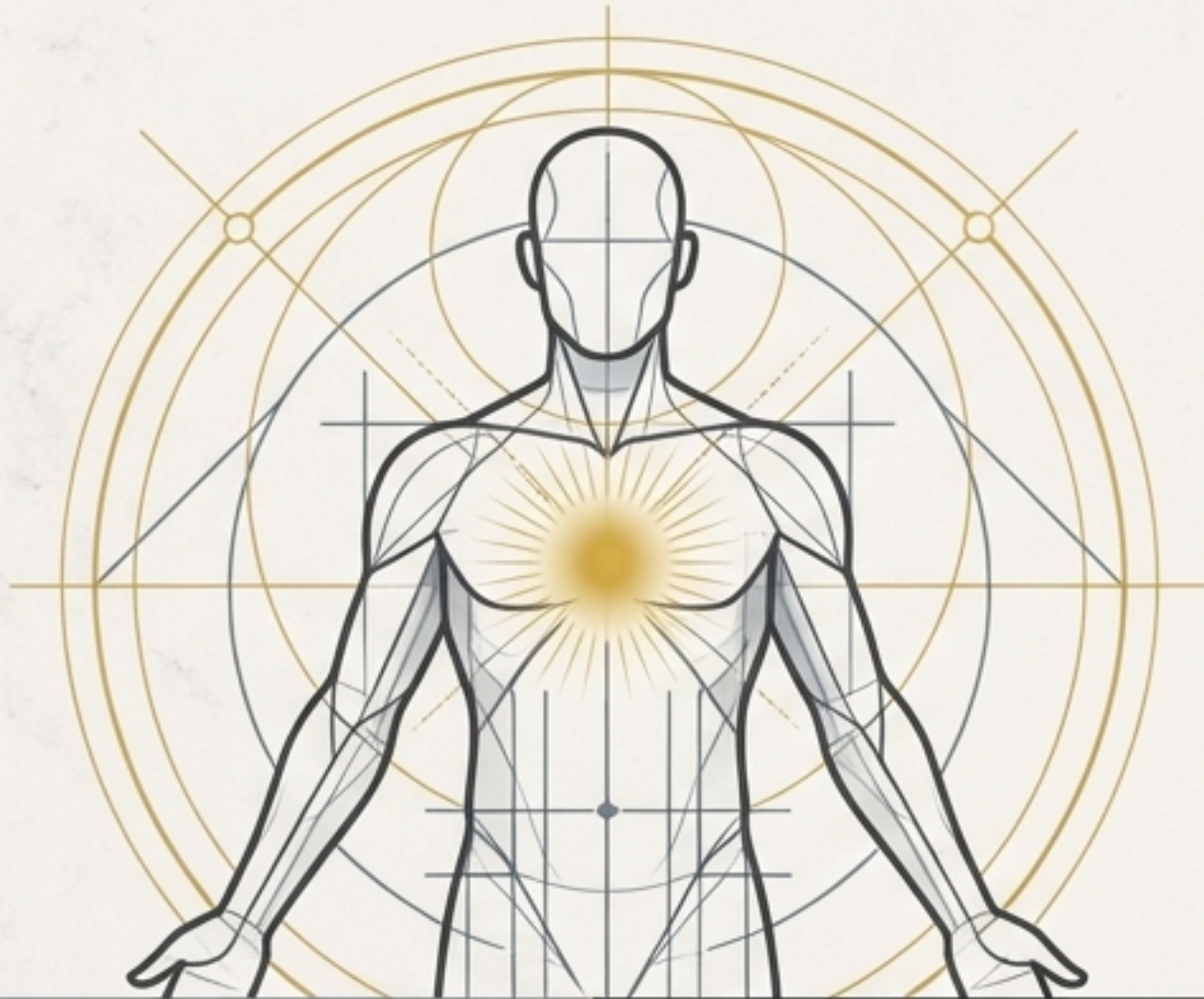

Foundation 2: What is Humanity?

God made us in His image and likeness so that we would relate to Him, represent Him, and rule the world with Him.



- We depend on Him for our existence; **He breathed life** into us (Genesis 2:7). We are both spiritual and physical beings.
- We are His **priests** on earth, placed in the Garden to “work it and watch over it” (Genesis 2:15) – terms later used for priestly service in the temple.
- Our **purpose** is to serve God as His **representatives** in everything we do.

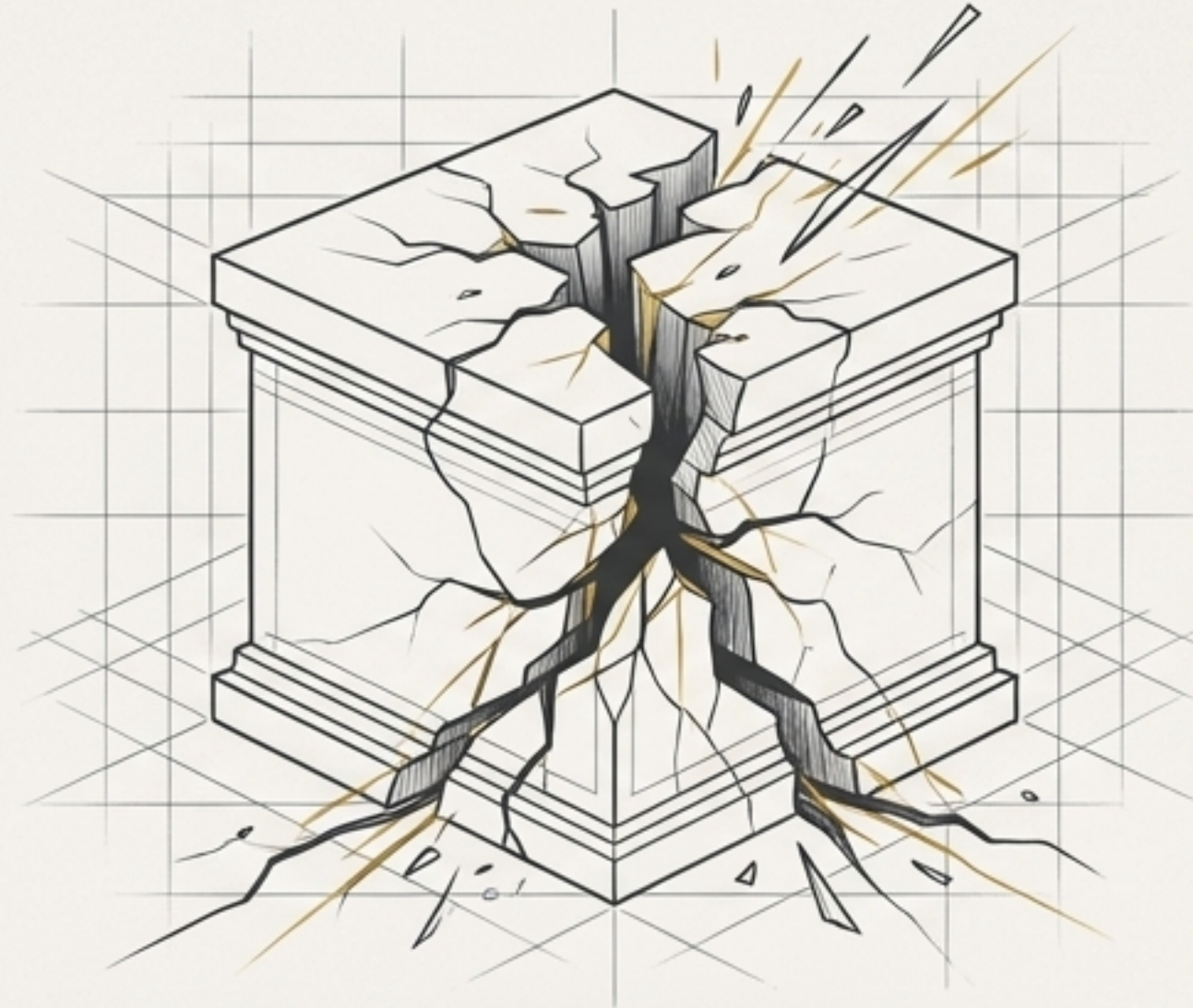

Foundation 3: What is the Problem?

The Cause

Adam and Eve's choice to rebel against God and declare independence by eating from "the tree of the knowledge of good and evil" (Genesis 2:17). They wanted to decide for themselves what is good and right.



The Result

- Spiritual and physical death.
- Alienation from God and each other.
- Expulsion from the Garden and abandonment of their priestly calling.

The Evidence

Death began to **dominate**, manifesting in conflict (Cain kills Abel, Gen 4:8) and pride (Lamech's boast, Gen 4:24).

Foundation 4: What is the Solution?

All is not lost. God stepped into the mess with a solution and offers a way back.



Presence

God did not abandon Adam and Eve. He sought them, spoke to them, and clothed them (Genesis 3:21).



Promise

He will strike your head, and you will strike his heel. (Genesis 3:15).



Path

He made a way for worship, accepting Abel's offering.

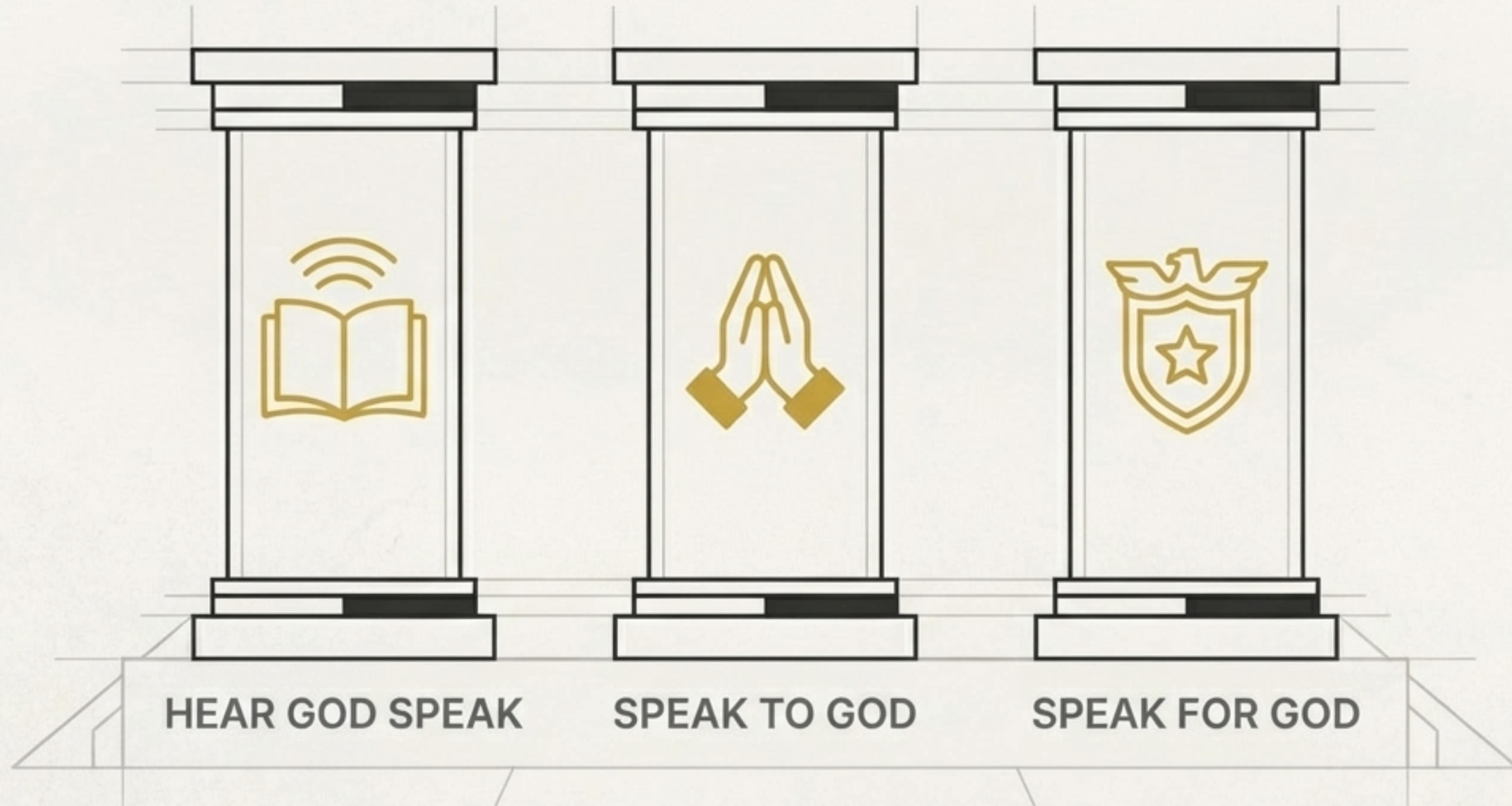
The Ultimate Fulfillment: God invites everyone to eat from the Tree of Life by turning to Jesus Christ.

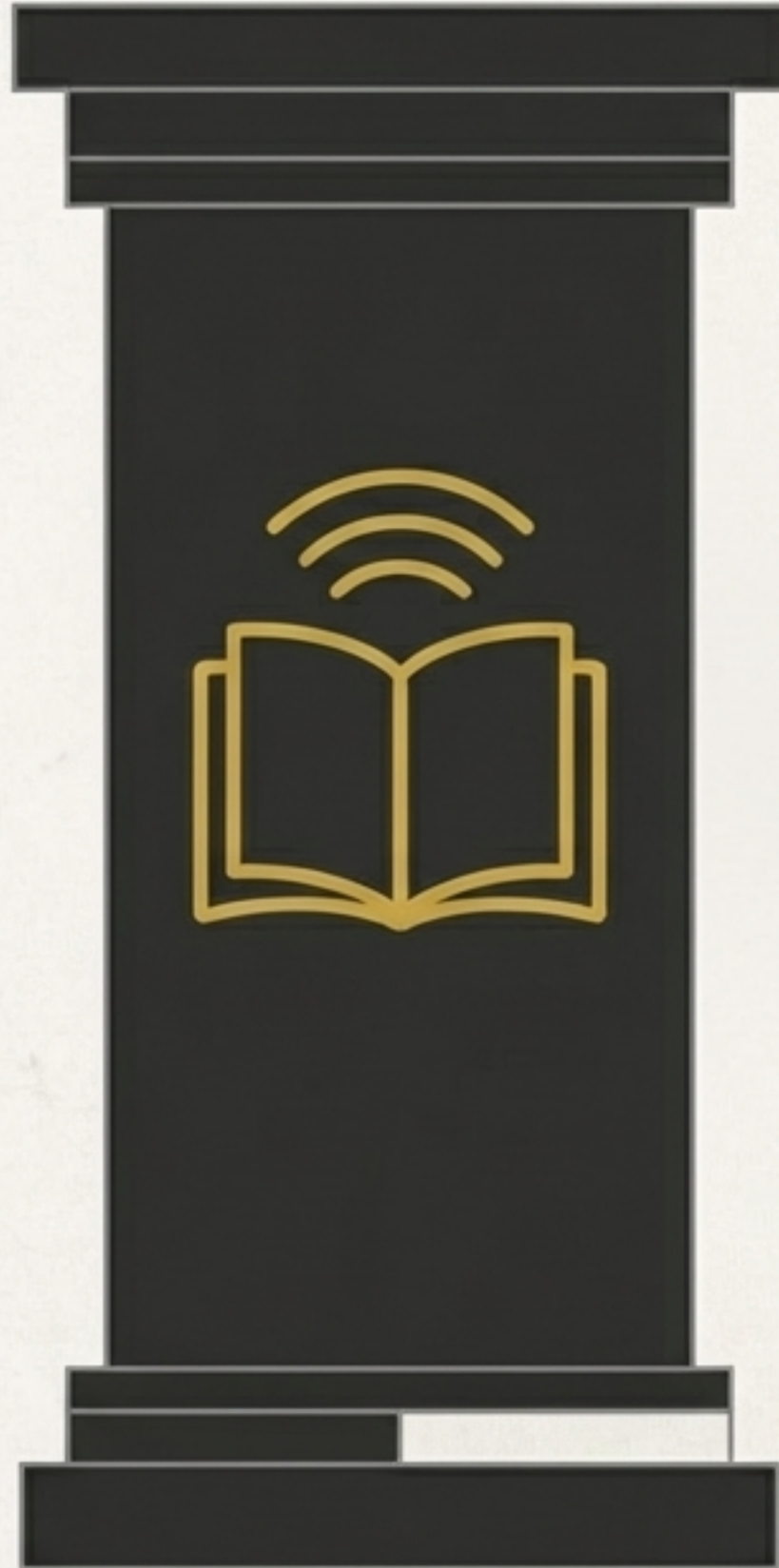
From Foundation to Application

Our 2026 Vision: Three Pillars for a Deeper Relationship with God





Pillar 1: We Will Focus on Hearing God Speak

Core Principle: God wants a relationship with us, and He speaks through His Word. We will be a people of the Book.

Action Steps for 2026:

- **Personal:** Every person follows a Bible reading plan (e.g., Foundations 260, Bible app, Study Bibles).
- **Corporate:** We will incorporate Bible study into every small group.
- **Reputation:** We will be known as a Bible-teaching church, the place to be for anyone wanting to learn Scripture.



Pillar 2: We Will Focus on Speaking to God

Core Principle: Prayer is our part in the relationship with God. He speaks through His Word; we respond in prayer. Intercession is our priestly calling.

Action Steps for 2026:

- Incorporate significant prayer into worship services.
- Prioritize prayer in small groups (Appoint a prayer leader in each group).
- Use a prayer guide for daily prayer (Guides are available at the book table).
- **Attend the Prayer Meeting for 2026 on Saturday, January 24.**
