WHAT IS A DISCIPLE?

The basic definition of a disciple is:

A disciple follows Jesus Christ by embracing his will and ways.

His will: A disciple obeys Jesus' command to repent or turn from oneself and sin to trust in him as our God and Savior. A disciple surrenders his life to Christ: "Wherever you lead, I will follow."

His ways: A disciple studies Jesus' teachings (the Bible) and obeys them by faith and the Holy Spirit's power.

What does that look like in real life?

HOW DOES A DISCIPLE LIVE?

The apostle Paul wrote to Timothy, his ministry partner and a leader in the church in Ephesus. He gave him lots of wise advice about his life and ministry.

In one passage, Paul provided a profile of a faithful disciple of Jesus. He listed six marks of a Jesus-follower. This is how we should strive to live even when we're young:

1 Timothy 4:12 (CSB) Don't let anyone despise your youth, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity.

1. **Example:** People should be able to watch our lives and guess that we are disciples of Jesus.
2. **In word:** Our speech should always be godly, wise, honest, positive, encouraging, and loving (see Ephesians 4:15, 29).
3. **In conduct:** We faithfully follow Jesus' teachings so our lives are marked by obedience to him. We must not be hypocrites: *Titus 1:16 (CSB) They claim to know God, but they deny him by their works.*
4. **In love:** We love God and people from the heart.
5. **In faith:** We trust God and are faithful to Him. Genuine faith always leads to faithfulness.
6. **In purity:** We reject the godless ways of the world, especially in relationships. We follow the Bible's teachings on sexual conduct.
