THE JUDGMENT SEAT OF CHRIST

2 Corinthians 5:8-10 (ESV) Yes, we are of good courage, and we would rather be away from the body and at home with the Lord. 9 So whether we are at home or away, we make it our aim to please him. 10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil.

Verse 8: courage in anticipation of our end-times resurrection.

Verse 9: motivation to please the Lord.

Verse 10: three facts about the judgment seat of Christ.

Fact One: Jesus Will Be the Judge

10 ... the judgment seat **OF** Christ.

John 19:13 (ESV) So when Pilate heard these words, he brought Jesus out and sat down on the judgment seat at a place called The Stone Pavement, and in Aramaic Gabbatha.

Fact Two: Jesus Will Judge the Saints

10 ... so that each one may receive

2 Corinthians 1:1 (ESV) To the church of God that is at Corinth, with all the saints who are in the whole of Achaia:

Romans 14:10, 12 (ESV) ... For we will all stand before the judgment seat of God; ... 12 So then each of us will give an account of himself to God.

Fact Three: Jesus Will Give the Saints their Due

10 ... so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil..

1 Corinthians 4:5 (ESV) 5 Therefore do not pronounce judgment before the time, before the Lord comes, who will bring to light the things now hidden in darkness and will disclose the purposes of the heart. Then each one will receive his commendation from God.

THE GREAT WHITE THRONE JUDGMENT

Revelation 20:11-15 (ESV) Then I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it. From his presence earth and sky fled away, and no place was found for them. 12 And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Then another book was opened, which is the book of life. And the dead were judged by what was written in the books, according to what they had done. 13 And the sea gave up the dead who were in it, Death and Hades gave up the dead who were in them, and they were judged, each one of them, according to what they had done. 14 Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. 15 And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

The final judgment is "the most serious, sobering, and tragic passage in the entire Bible" (John MacArthur, Commentary on Revelation).

Fact One: Jesus Will Be the Judge

Revelation 20:11 (ESV) Then I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it.

John 5:22 (ESV) ... the Father judges no one, but has given all judgment to the Son ...

2 Timothy 4:1 (ESV) I charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead ...

Fact Two: Jesus Will Judge the Dead

12 And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Then another book was opened, which is the book of life. And the dead were judged by what was written in the books, according to what they had done. 13 And the sea gave up the dead who were in it, Death and Hades gave up the dead who were in them, and they were judged, each one of them, according to what they had done.

Fact 3: Jesus Will Condemn the Dead

14 Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. 15 And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

Revelation 14:9-11 (ESV) And another angel, a third, followed them, saying with a loud voice, "If anyone worships the beast and its image and receives a mark on his forehead or on his hand, 10 he also will drink the wine of God's wrath, poured full strength into the cup of his anger, and he will be tormented with fire and sulfur in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb. 11 And the smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever, and they have no rest, day or night, these worshipers of the beast and its image, and whoever receives the mark of its name."
