## I WISH I'D LISTENED

**In May, Kim and I were headed to Wheaton, IL ...**

**"Open to reason" = teachable.**

James 3:17 (ESV) But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, **open to reason**, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere.

## IT'S WISE TO LISTEN TO WISE ADVICE

**Relationship Principle #3: It's wise to listen to wise advice.**

Proverbs 12:15 ESV The way of a fool is right in his own eyes, but a wise man listens to advice.

**Listening to unwise advice can sabotage relationships.**

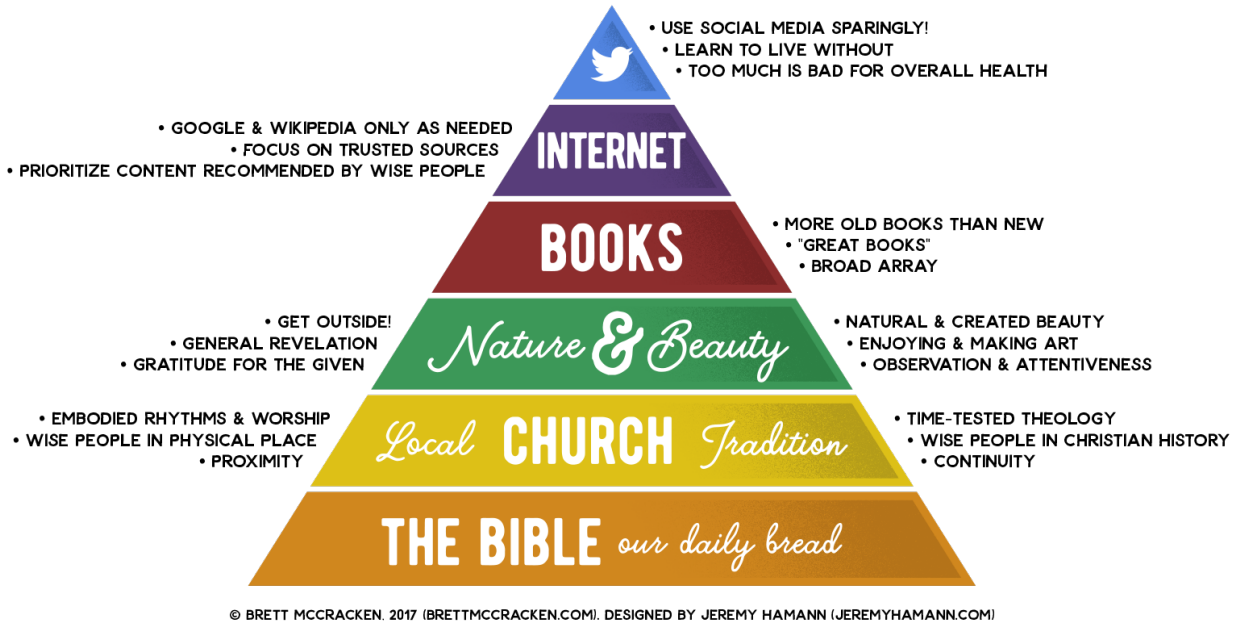
1 Kings 12:6-8 ESV Then King Rehoboam took counsel with the old men, who had stood before Solomon his father while he was yet alive, saying, "How do you advise me to answer this people?" And they said to him, "If you will be a servant to this people today and serve them, and speak good words to them when you answer them, then they will be your servants forever." But he abandoned the counsel that the old men gave him and took counsel with the young men who had grown up with him and stood before him **(they advised him to bully people)**.

- It's good the king sought advice.
- It's not good that he followed unwise advice. Carefully evaluate.

# WHERE TO FIND WISE ADVICE

## McCracken: The Wisdom Pyramid: Feeding Your Soul in a Post-Truth World.

### Wisdom Pyramid



**His point is simple: Garbage in, garbage out. So guard what goes in.**

- Wisdom from social media = least reliable, least "nutritious." Limit intake.
- Wisdom from the Bible = most reliable, most "nutritious." Increase intake.

Proverbs 2:6-7 (ESV) For the LORD gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding; 7 he stores up sound wisdom for the upright ...

- Wisdom from our church = can be reliable and "nutritious." Increase intake.

# FINDING WISDOM IN OUR CHURCH

**There are three sources of wisdom in our church:**

## **1. Wisdom from our worship celebrations and other gatherings.**

- God is front and center.
- His wisdom (Bible) is read, taught, prayed and sung.

James 1:5 (ESV) If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him

## **Wisdom from the history of God's people.**

- We have thousands of years of accumulated wisdom - books & traditions.
- Embrace the good and helpful; e.g. Liturgy, confessions, catechisms, etc.

Proverbs 15:14 (ESV) The heart of him who has understanding seeks knowledge but the mouths of fools feed on folly.

## **Wisdom from our wise brothers and sisters in the church.**

- The church family is a living library of godly knowledge, skill, insight..

Proverbs 19:20 ESV Listen to advice and accept instruction, that you may gain wisdom in the future.

## **AVOID TWO MISTAKES**

**Do not divorce wisdom from \_\_\_\_\_.**

Proverbs 1:7 ESV The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction.

**Do not divorce wisdom from \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus Christ.**

1 Corinthians 1:30-31 (ESV) And because of him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God ... (Also Colossians 2:3).
