Our Faith Will Be Tested

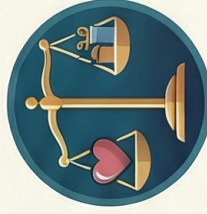
Testing Proves Genuineness

Our God Will Keep His Word

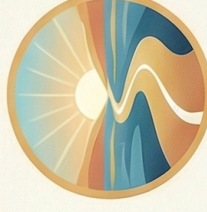
God's Timing is Perfect
