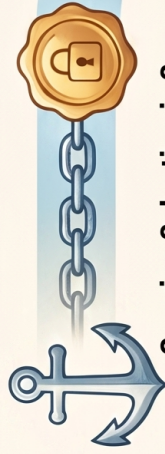

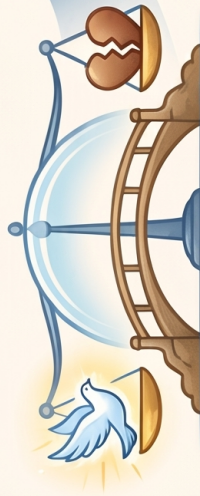
Genuine Salvation is Secure

Covenant vs. Common Law

The Value of Written Prayer

Using Psalms or historic liturgies is valid prayer if the heart and mind are fully engaged.
