THE THREE-PART TEACHING CURRICULUM

Share "God Stories" to Spark Wonder

Use concrete Bible events and stories of Jesus to build imagination and relatable faith.

Teach the Fullness of God's Character

Balance God's justice with His mercy to instill both healthy awe and deep love.

Point to God's Saving Power

Use the Cross to show children they are sinners in need of a Savior.



Gap in Spiritual Intent vs. Reality
