FAITH TO ADVANCE GOD'S MISSION

FAITH IS NON-NEGOTIABLE

All of God's people need faith.

We are saved through faith, follow Jesus by faith, and lives lives of faith.

However, there are different kinds of faith.

- "Everyday" faith needs only the faith of a mustard seed.
- "Leadership" faith must be as big as a mountain.
- Leaders need deep, robust, unquenchable faith.

LEADERSHIP FAITH

Joshua models leadership faith for us to emulate.

 We need men and women who say yes to God even when he asks them to do hard things.

Numbers 13-14 provides an example of leadership faith.

- Moses sent the 12 spies into the Promised Land to scout it out.
- The spies were divided between men of faith and men of unbelief.
- Read Numbers 13-14.

JOSHUA'S LEADERSHIP FAITH

1. Leadership faith is God-exalting - Numbers 14:5-6.

Numbers 14:6 (CSB) Joshua son of Nun and Caleb son of Jephunneh, who were among those who scouted out the land, tore their clothes...

- Joshua and Caleb were devastated by the ten spies lack of faith and the mob's reaction. Why?
- Because it robbed God of his glory. It denied his power and faithfulness.
- We need leaders who glorify God at all costs. Their God is great and greatly to be praised.

2. Leadership faith is promise-driven - Numbers 14:7-8.

Numbers 14:8a (CSB) If the LORD is pleased with us, he will bring us into this land...

- Joshua believed they would take the Land, not because of his military skill or the size of his army.
- He believed the Land Promise Genesis 12:7; 15:18; 17:18; 26:3-4; 28:13;
 Deuteronomy 30:4-5.
- The church needs leaders who stand on the promises of God. For example:
 - God will be our all-sufficient strength 2 Corinthians 12:9
 - Everyone who calls on the Name of the Lord will be saved Romans 10:13-15
 - Jesus will build his church Matthew 16:18
 - He will shield us from Satan's attacks Ephesians 6:10-18
 - Where God guides, he provides Philippians 4:19
- We need leaders who are filled with courage and conviction because they believe in the promise-keeping God.

3. Leadership faith is fear-fighting - Numbers 14:9-10.

Numbers 14:9 (CSB) Only don't rebel against the LORD, and don't be afraid of the people of the land, for we will devour them.

 Leadership faith isn't the absence of fear; it's believing that advancing God's mission is more important than feeling comfortable. We need leaders who fear nothing but God and don't need the crowd's approval.

INACTION IS NOT AN OPTION

We need leaders who believe they were made for more than taking a back seat while the world goes to hell without Jesus.

- · We have a mission to accomplish.
- It begins in our families and extends to the ends of the earth.

- What are the facets of faith Christian leaders today must develop? For example, not pleasing people, conviction, etc? Discuss examples.
- What can you and your group do to advance God's mission to make disciples of all nations?
