The Foundation of Prayer



Conversation Before Intercession

Prioritize personal relationship and presence with God before making specific requests or petitions.



Justice



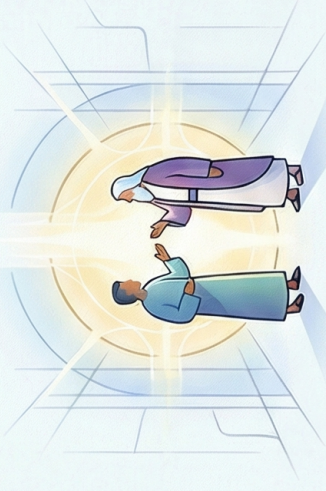
Mercy

Prayer Based on Character

Align your requests with God's established nature of justice, mercy, and faithfulness.



The "True God" vs. The "Genie God"



Genie God Concept

Keeps us from all hardship
Meets every impulsive want
Judges those we don't like



The True God of the Blueprint

- Goes with us through the darkest valley
- Provides daily bread and meets needs
- Pray for God's presence in hardship rather than demanding He simply remove all problems.

The Practice of Intercession

Intercede with Bold Persistence

Like Abraham negotiating for Sodom, offer audacious, repeated requests that reflect God's heart for people.



The Intercessor's Request

What if there are 50 righteous?

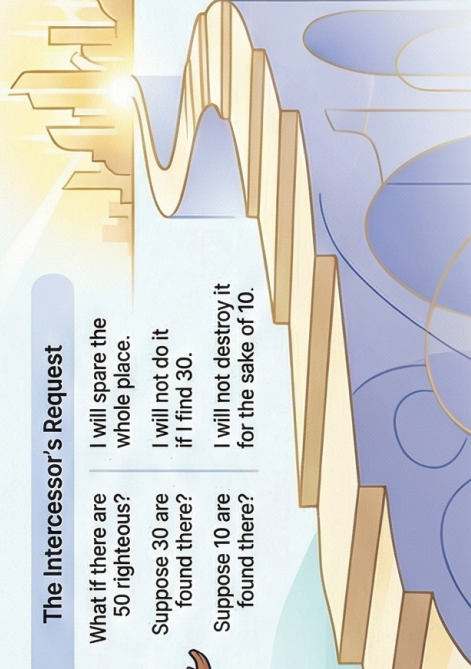
I will spare the whole place.

Suppose 30 are found there?

I will not do it if I find 30.

Suppose 10 are found there?

I will not destroy it for the sake of 10.



Maintain Humble Posture

Recognize the privilege of access to God, approaching Him as "dust and ashes" without entitlement.



Prayer as Divine Partnership

God invites ordinary people into His plans, making our prayers essential to how He works.
